Woodford County Library: Help Us Grow!

In 1903, Woodford County native Margaret Logan bequeathed money for a library to be built in Versailles, Kentucky, in honor of her late nephew Logan Helm.

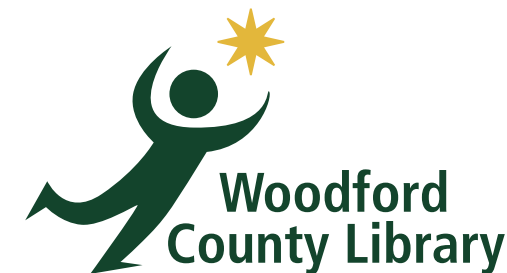
The site at 115 North Main Street was chosen for its proximity to downtown businesses and local neighborhoods.

Over 100 years later, the library still stands at the same location in our vibrant historic downtown and is undergoing the most extensive renovation and expansion in the library's history.

The library board hired Sherman Carter Barnhart Architects to design a beautiful library, keeping the Beaux Arts theme while incorporating modern elements needed for a public library today. The cost of renovating the 100-year-old building and doubling its current size is over \$3.5 million.

With over 100 thousand visitors per year, the library serves the community by providing a variety of materials. In the 21st century, this means more than just books. Today, a successful public library has computers with high-speed Internet access, audio-visual materials, programs for children and adults, meeting space, a trained staff and much more.

Naming Opportunities: *First Floor*

- 1 Children's Library: \$250,000
- 2 Main Library Gallery: \$150,000
- 3 Community Meeting Room: \$100,000
- 4 Children's Programming Room: \$50,000

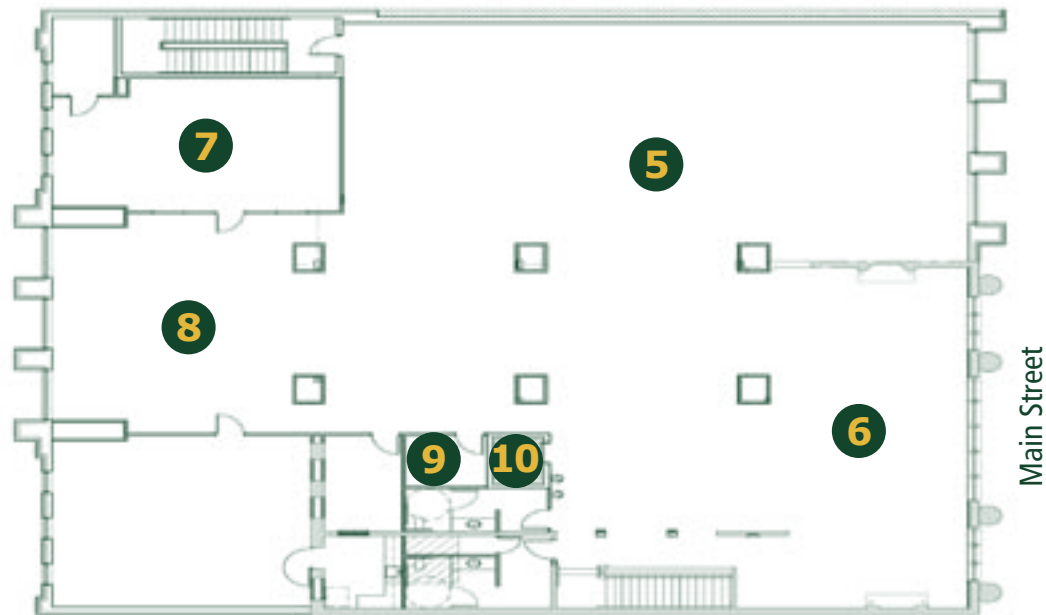
The first floor of the library will be home to the new and expanded Children's Library, designed as a horse farm. The Main Library Gallery, the Community Meeting Room, and the Children's Programming Room will also be located on the first floor.



Naming Opportunities: *Second Floor*

- 5** Adult Library: \$250,000
- 6** Periodical Reading Room: \$150,000
- 7** Art Gallery: \$100,000
- 8** Young Adult Library: \$75,000
- 9** Large Study Room: \$25,000
- 10** Small Study Room: \$10,000

The second floor of the library will house the Adult Library collection, the Young Adult Library, computers and quiet study rooms. The Art Gallery will provide a permanent location to display rotating exhibits featuring local artists.



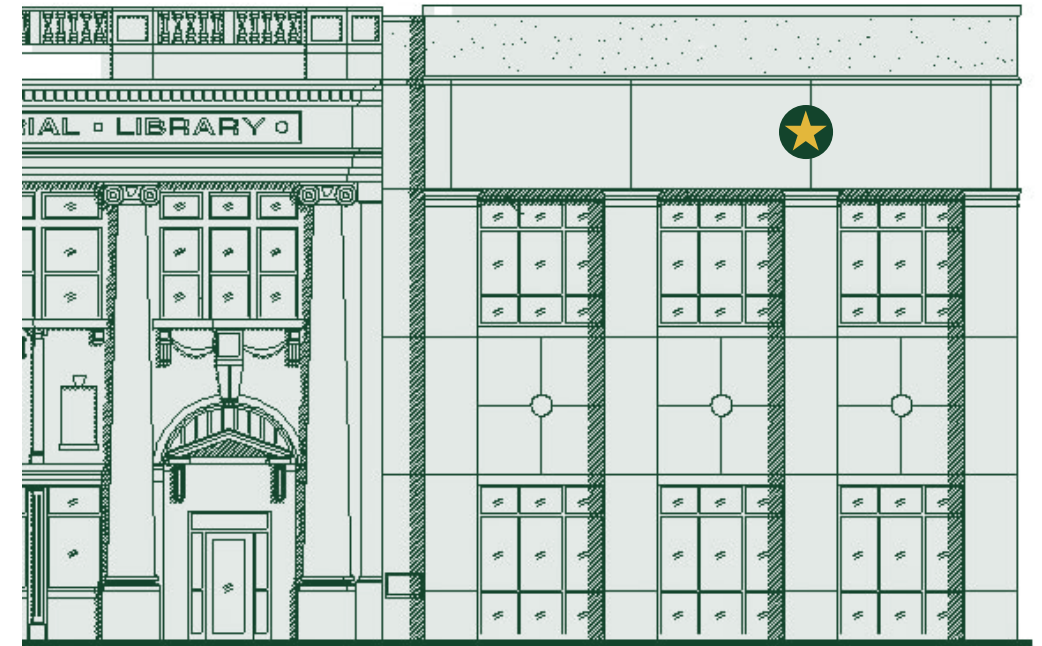
Naming Opportunity: *Library Annex*

Your name, or that of a loved one, can become an enduring part of Main Street – featured on the facade of our beautiful new Library Annex.

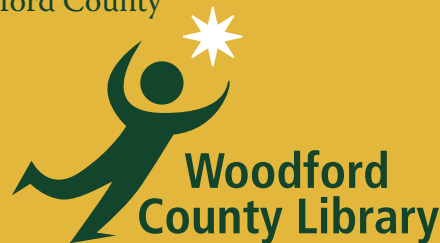
