A&M Aerial Photography is based in Lexington KY. Our primary focus is to provide high quality, aerial, digital photography services to various clients in the central Kentucky area. Aerial photographs are taken from our remote controlled, unmanned helicopter which is powered by a very quiet electric motor. We use a Canon 20D professional digital SLR camera to capture the highest quality images.

Our remote-controlled, battery-powered, helicopter camera ship provides several advantages over a full-size helicopter. The photos are generally sharper since our remote controlled platform is able to get into smaller quarters and fly at lower altitudes than a full-size helicopter. Noise is a concern for some locations and our battery powered helicopter is whisper quiet. Overhead costs are relatively small resulting in substantial savings passed on to the customer. A typical photo shoot costs about 20% of what you would pay for a full-size helicopter to do the same job, delivering equivalent or better quality images. And we guarantee satisfaction.

Scheduling

In most cases, a few days notice is all that is required to schedule a shoot. Time permitting, rush jobs can be scheduled for an additional fee. Proof images can be delivered via email to you or your web designer by the end of the day.

On-site

Total time from on-site arrival of pilot & photographer to helicopter ready to fly (begin shooting) is usually about 20-45 minutes. Total flight time is approximately 10-15 minutes. Safety and weather limitations are at our discretion as we cannot fly in inclement weather!
